S. R. O. No. 149/84.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to subsection (3) of section 1 of the Industrial Employment (Standing Orders) Act, 1946 (Central Act 20 of 1946), the Government of Kerala hereby apply the provisions of the said Act to Industrial Establishments for which the State Government are the appropriate Government as defined in clause (b) of section 2 of the said Act, wherein fifty or more but less than one hundred persons are employed or were employed on any day of the preceding twelve months, the same having been previously published under Notification No. G. O. Rt. 19/83/LBR dated the 7th January, 1983 as, S.R.O. No. 352/83 in Part I of Kerala Gazette No. 12 dated the 22nd March, 1983 as required under the above provision.

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the notification but is intended to indicate its general purport).

The Central Government have extended the application of the provisions of the Industrial Employment (Standing Orders) Act, 1946 to the industrial establishments, in respect of which they are the appropriate Government, wherein 50 or more but less than 100 workers are employed. The Government of Kerala also intend to apply the provisions of the said Act to Industrial Establishments in respect of which they are the appropriate Government, wherein 50 or more but less than one hundred workers are employed.

This notification is intended to achieve the above object.
