S. R. O. No. 234/2014.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 29 of the Trade Unions Act, 1926 (Central Act XVI of 1926) read with sub-section (3) of section 30 thereof, the Government of Kerala hereby make the following regulations further to amend the Kerala Trade Union Regulations, 1958 the same having been previously published under notification No. 3488/E3/2013/LBR dated 9th October, 2013 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 3045 dated 24th October, 2013 as required under sub-section (1) of section 30 of the said Act, namely:—

REGULATIONS

- 1. Short title and commencement.—(1) These regulations may be called the Kerala Trade Unions (Amendment) Regulations, 2014.
 - (2) They shall come into force at once.
- 2. Amendment of the Regulations.—In the Kerala Trade Union Regulations, 1958, after regulation 3, the following regulation shall be inserted, namely:—
- "3A. Time limit for the disposal of application for Registration.—The Registrar appointed under section 3 shall either grant or reject the application for registration of a Trade Union within sixty days on receipt of the application for the said purpose".

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

Considering the problems in Non-Registration and delay in registration of Trade Unions, Government have decided to incorporate a provision for prescribing a time limit of sixty days for the disposal of application for Registration in the Kerala Trade Unions Regulations, 1958 to avoid delays in registration of Trade Unions.

This notification is intended to achieve the above object.
